Step	Potential Hazards	Safe Procedures/Crew Responsibilities
Preparation		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Designate a Competent Person or persons Review P3 (Preparation Planning Procedures) and Hazard Analysis with crew* Complete and review STA's daily
Transport barriers	Hit by barrier that falls off truck	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Secure loads with straps or chains in good condition Make sure load has not shifted before removing straps/chains Stay a safe distance from edge of trailer
Unload barriers	Hitting overhead utility lines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select unloading location that is not under utility lines
	Personnel falling off trailer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move to a safe location before the barrier is lifted
	Equipment failure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use proper size equipment for task
	Rigging failure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use proper rigging to lift barriers; inspect rigging prior to use
	Barriers or lift points breaking apart during lifting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inspect the condition of barriers and lift points Stay well away from barrier while it is suspended in the air Never walk under, or place any part of your body under a suspended load
