Step	Potential Hazards	Safe Procedures/ Crew Responsibilities
<b>Preparation</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Designate a Competent Person</li> <li>• Review P3 (Preparation Planning Procedures) and JHA (Job Hazard Analysis) with crew</li> <li>• Complete and review STA (Safety Task Assessment) daily</li> </ul>
<b>Haul material</b>	Back into other equipment, vehicles, or people on foot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check mirrors before backing up</li> <li>• Make radio or eye contact when other equipment or people on foot are nearby</li> <li>• Keep all vehicles and personnel out of stockpile work area if they are not needed there</li> </ul>
	Back-off edge of pile	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keep backup ramp onto stockpile away from edge of stockpile</li> <li>• Build berms along top edge and sides of ramp onto stockpile</li> </ul>
<b>Dump material</b>	Tip haul unit over	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do not drive on steep inclines</li> <li>• Make sure truck is level side to side while dumping</li> </ul>
<b>Push-up material</b>	Rocks rolling and hitting other vehicles or people	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use berms or other means to contain rocks and cobbles from rolling into other operations</li> </ul>
	Unauthorized vehicles on stockpile after hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Close off ramp at night</li> </ul>
